(Excerpts from her time as a young journalist for the progressive women's magazine Seitô, around 1916, six years before her being murdered in police custody):

The New Woman does not follow in the footsteps of previous women

She even ignores these steps

She takes the path of a New Woman

She goes further

Continues in a direction where most have come to a halt

She's a pathfinder

Stung by poisonous insects

She sheds bitter tears

Those who only know the old path

Those who got stuck there

They don't even recognise her new ways

Even with her as a guide, this path is new

Courage grows on that new path
